THE DATE: FROM 29TH TO 30TH APRIL 2024 - FLORENCE - ITALY

THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE WILL BE HELD BOTH IN PERSON AND ONLINE*

*Authors can also participate remotely and present their research works through a video recording or a ppt with audio that will be available for one year on our website.

Florence Heri-Tech was launched in 2018 by the [Department of Industrial Engineering of University of Florence \(DIEF\)](#) and [Florence Biennial Art and Restoration Fair](#). The idea was to create a synergy between Cultural Heritage and New Technologies. The Conference involves a large number of research projects and scholars from around the world and puts the industry's current issues under the spotlight, specifically on issues related to innovative techniques and technologies for Cultural Heritage. The Conference is part of the **Florence Biennial Art and Restoration Fair**, an international event attracting prestigious institutions and companies and creating a unique opportunity to bring together the academic world with industry. **The city of Florence will therefore be the international heart of Restoration and Cultural and Environmental assets as well as a forum for meeting and discussing for experts and enthusiasts from around the world.** The Conference will be a significant opportunity for exchange between researchers and companies for the **promotion of productive excellence, technological evolution**, the greater use of culture for younger sections of the population and specialization in the educational field for graduates and PhD students.

The final objectives:

Publication and scientific dissemination of the conference proceedings; promote international mobility and cooperation; promote the development of Europe as a multicultural society and encourage the scientific-cultural research; promoting international networks between universities, training institutes and companies to create long-term collaboration opportunities; create favorable conditions for the entry of young graduates into the world of work; demonstrate the influence of new technologies in the arts.

Numbers last edition: 180 participants – 3 plenary sessions – 4 parallel sessions - 126 Papers published.

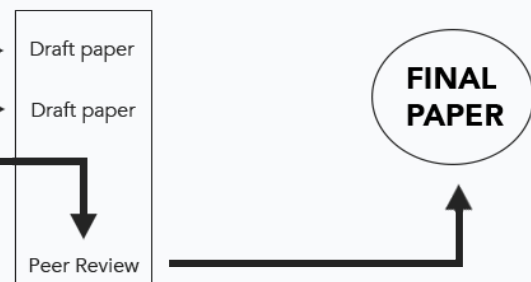

- 3) Draft paper

If your draft paper isn't ready, you can upload the basic information about the research (title, details of the author and co-authors, research area) or an abstract, and then you can proceed with the upload of the draft paper.

Draft papers submitted must have been peer reviewed in accordance with the **Springer's Peer Review Policy and subject to plagiarism checking.**

Once the draft paper has been approved and reviewed, you can upload the final paper, ready for the publication.

Deadline for submitting Draft Papers is March 25, 2024.

Deadline for submitting the Final Paper is June 14, 2024.

5. PAPER'S SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Authors willing to submit a Draft Paper can upload it on <https://equinocs.springernature.com/service/FlorenceHeri-Tech>, following the instructions below for the template. **Papers must be written in English. Papers submitted will be peer-reviewed by the TPC - Technical Program Committee based on originality, technical quality and presentation.** After your paper is accepted, you will be able to proceed with Registration.

Authors of accepted paper will receive an email from the conference secretariat with information on full paper submission and the registration procedure.

Preparing your Proceedings Paper - Short Instructions for Authors:

- Author can choose to work with word or latex. You can find the respective templates and instructions on our website (<https://www.florenceherittech.com/paper-submission/>).
 - The usage of these templates is not mandatory. Alternatively, you may either use a blank Word document or the standard LaTeX book class (for monographs) or article class (for individual contributions) and apply the default settings and styles (e.g., for heading styles, lists, footnotes, etc.).
 - The full paper has a maximum of **10-14 pages (ICT between 12 and 15 pages) - 400 words** per page (according to Springer Series formatting), including abstract, illustrations and bibliography.
 - Please prepare the chapter in one-column format.
 - Each chapter should begin with an abstract that summarize its content in no more than **200 words**. The abstract will appear online at SpringerLink and be available with unrestricted access to facilitate online searching, using e.g. Google, and allow unregistered users to read the abstract as a teaser for the complete chapter.
 - Authors should provide from **3 to 5 keywords**, separated by colons.
 - For authors working with a Word document: please avoid inserting equations as graphic files. Use the Math function of Word 2003 or 2007, MathType or Microsoft Equation Editor to create your equations.
 - Please include all affiliations and e-mail addresses (or at least the email address of the corresponding author) in the chapter you submit to the book editors. The e-mail addresses will be used by SpringerNature to provide authors with a personal account where they can download a free copy of the eBook upon publication.
 - Permissions for any material authors want to reuse from previous publication should be obtained by the corresponding publisher they want to reuse. Authors can GET PERMISSION online by using RightsLink: <http://www.copyright.com/publishers/rightslink-scientific/>. Moreover, Springer is a STM signatory publisher. 6. PEER REVIEW AND INFORMATION ABOUT REVIEWERS

Draft papers will be subject to double-blind review and plagiarism checking.

All the authors will be reviewers. To each author will be sent an invitation to become a reviewer via EquinOCS. You can accept or reject the invitation. Authors who become reviewers will be assigned draft papers in their area of expertise.
